The landscaping package surrounding this Denver home includes a wide range of stone materials from around the world installed to exact performance standards.

The Gallegos Corp. placed hand-carved Golden Granite from China at the arrival court fountains and paving that offer an amazing entrance to the project. Carved Mountain Green Granite from Minnesota is used for the spectacular cascade fountain, which is one of only three like it in the world, and serves as the centerpiece for a series of pools and waterfalls. Pawnee Buff and Colorado

Rose sandstone cover all of the residence's flatwork and Zen patios laid in ornamental patterns. Cottonwood limestone from Kansas forms the very detailed entrance monument



into the property.

The beauty of the various materials is rivaled only by the level of skill displayed by the masons in creating this project.
