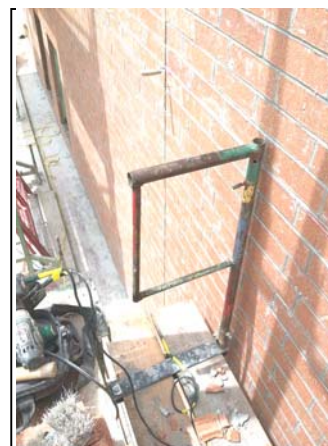

Highway Clean-Up

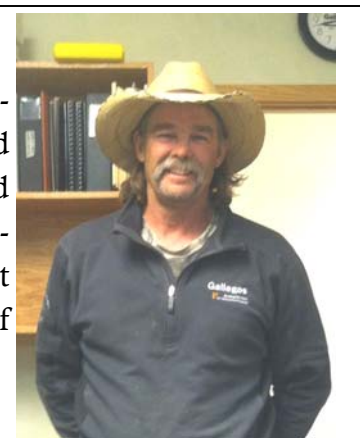

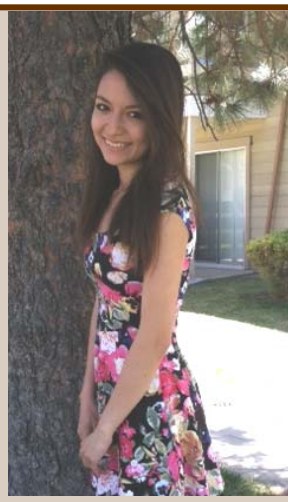

Graduating Seniors



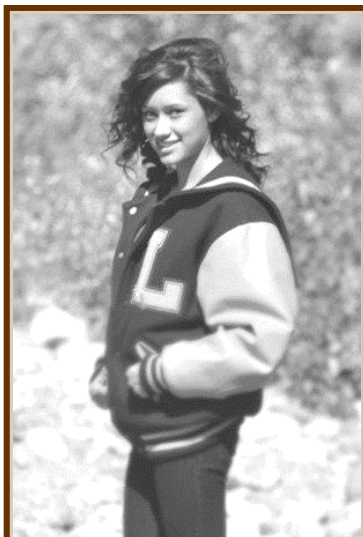

Frank Gutierrez's (94) daughter Sierra graduated from Red Canyon High School this year. She plans on pursuing her dreams in music.

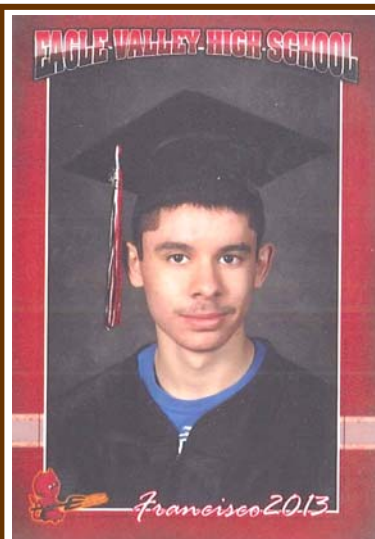

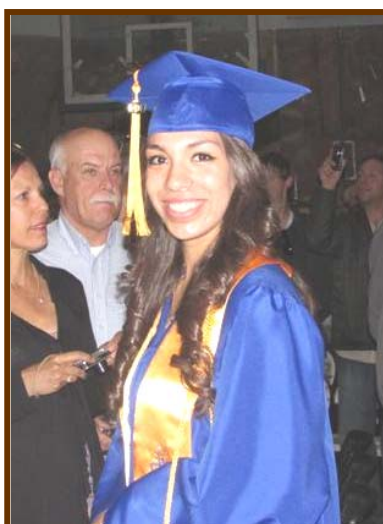

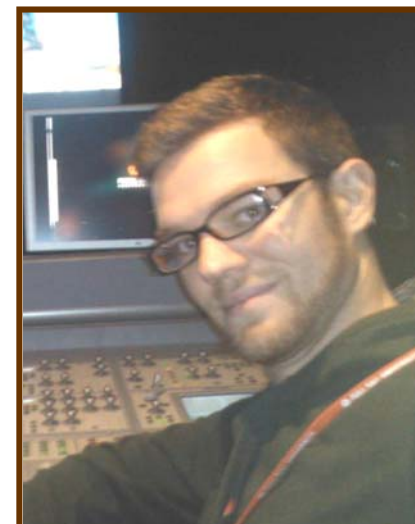
Mike Woods (10) son Christopher graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder with a degree in Bio-Chemical Engineering.
